IFCC has Officially Submitting PEFC Endorsement for the Requirements of Sustainable Community Forest Management Certification

IFCC (Indonesian Forestry Certification Cooperation) as a national organisation initiated the implementation of forestry certification in Indonesia using PEFC (Programme For The Endorsement of Forest Certification) scheme, was established on 9th September 2011. The IFCC sustainable forest management certification scheme has been officially endorsed by PEFC since 1st October 2014.

The next year after the endorsement from PEFC, IFCC initiated the drafting of certification requirements for sustainable community forest management. Since 1st October 2015, IFCC has undertaken a process of formulating sustainable, transparent, and stakeholder legacy forest management certification requirements by establishing a consensus among them (the Standardization Committee). The requirements of IFCC sustainable community forest management was an initiative project by IFCC, which was also the project of PEFC Collaboration Fund in 2015.

The process of preparing the IFCC sustainable community forest management certification requirements consists of several stages: the design stage of the activity, the preparation stage, the stages of the standardization committee, the question stage (trials, member consultation and public consultation), approval stage, and publication stage. All of these stages are done based on the document formulation of IFCC PD 1001 standard that can be downloaded [here](#).

The requirements of IFCC sustainable community forest management certification were compiled by the IFCC Standardization Committee comprising stakeholder representatives (businesses and industries, children and youth, forest owners / managers, indigenous peoples, local governments, NGOs, scientific and technological communities, women and workers, and labor union). Required requirements are consulted publicly for feedback / comments. Public consultations are conducted by publications on the IFCC website, communications via mailinglist, email distribution stakeholders, and regional seminars. The IFCC standardization committee has conducted public consultations via mailinglist, email and website during the period 3rd September – 2nd October 2016, then extended and closed on 16th March 2017. Regional seminars for public consultation was held in Yogyakarta on 6th October 2016. The document of the IFCC sustainable community forest management certification requirements compiled based on stakeholders consensus (Standardization Committee) were submitted to the IFCC Board of Director. The IFCC Board of Director recommended the compiled requirements to the IFCC General Assembly. The IFCC General Assembly authorized the IFCC sustainable community forest management certification requirements on 26th April 2017. On Wednesday, 23rd August 2017, the IFCC Chairman Dr. Ir. Dradjad H. has formally sent the Application Letter No. 003/KSK/SK-BP/VIII/2017 to the PEFC Council as a notice that IFCC has completed the preparation of the IFCC sustainable community forest management certification requirements and interested in obtaining PEFC endorsement.

The whole process of compilation is summarized in the standard setting report.
